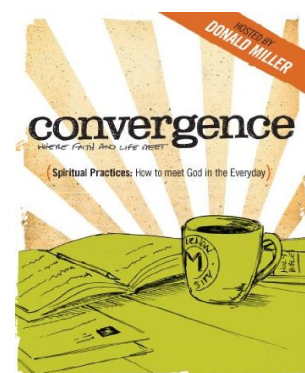

A three-week study that looks at how spiritual practices such as prayer, observing the Sabbath and fasting can

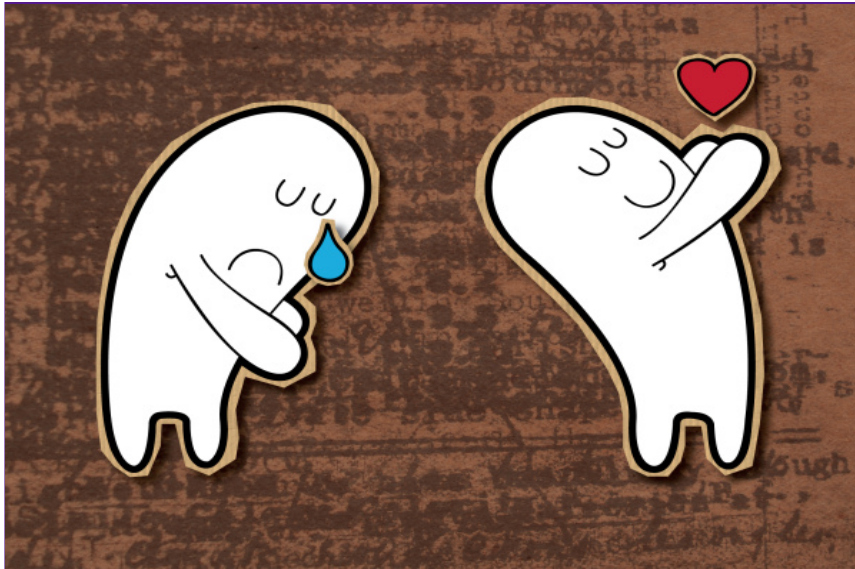
